INSTRUCTIONS TO ASSESSOR

NOTICE;--It is the duty of the Assessor when notified to appraise damages to domestic animals caused by rabies. This is in accordance with Article 6A, Section 105C, "Such assessor, immediately upon receiving such notification, shall inquire into the matter. If he deems it necessary, he shall examine witnesses in relation thereto. No indemnification shall be paid unless there shall be presented to the assessor a report from a laboratory officially approved for rabies examination by the State Commissioner of Health, showing the presence of rabies in each animal for which indemnity is claimed. If the assessor is satisfied that the animal or animals died of rabies, he shall determine the amount of the damages resulting there from and shall thereupon make a report in the form prescribed by the Commissioner and shall state therein the amount of damages. The report shall be signed by the assessor, one copy of which shall be accompanied by an official laboratory report showing presence of rabies. Two copies of the report shall be filed by the assessor in the office of the county treasurer, and a third copy shall be delivered by the assessor to the claimant**."

When the assessor is not satisfied that the loss was caused by rabies the claim must be disallowed, marking on this report the reason for disallowing the claim and file the report as directed above.

INDEMNIFICATION FOR RABIES

The amounts allowed for indemnification shall not exceed the actual damage and shall not exceed the sum of \$500 for each animal in the case of horses and cattle, or \$150 for each animal in the case of swine, goats or sheep; except however, in the case of registered purebred bovine animals indemnification may not exceed \$700 for each animal. If appraised at purebred value, registry certificate must accompany report.

The law provide that the boards of supervisors shall have the power to raise fund necessary to pay indemnification and that the State will reimburse the counties for 50% of the indemnification, such payments to be made quarterly on certification of the county treasurer.
