26A - Care of Animals by Pet Dealers****Section 401****A. Housing In/Out****1. Primary Enclosure Critical**

In the large kennel, there is no cover on the electrical outlet in one dog run containing 'Amy' & 'Skyler'. The run containing 'Willie' has chain link wire exposed that is bent out and sharp below the entrance to the dog's indoor enclosure. This sharp wire exposes the dog to possible injury.

2. Surfaces Critical

Six enclosed stalls in the indoor arena usually used for whelping & nursing puppies have areas between and surrounding the rubber mats used for flooring where bedding is caked and the dirt floor below the mats is exposed. One of these enclosures (currently housing a male Vizsla) contains an unsealed 4X4 post against the back wall where it adjoins the floor. Cannot view the entire post and previously viewed chewed area of the post as it is partially covered with shavings used for bedding. One enclosed stall in this same area used for isolation housing also has rubber mats for flooring that has areas between and around the mats where the dirt floor below is exposed and bedding is caked. Next to the enclosure containing the male Vizsla is an empty enclosure assumed ready for use where I viewed a dead partially desiccated frog on the floor. The next enclosure to the empty one contained a female Rhodesian Ridgeback with no pups. The front of the barn contains six stalls. One stall is empty but houses the two border collies that are out on the premise during the day. One other stall contains an adult border collie, three other stalls contain groups of weaned puppies of various breeds, the groups consisting of 3-7 puppies. The remaining stall is empty and approximately one quarter of the wall surface has been resealed. All of the six stalls have walls where the impervious surface has been compromised by the dogs chewing or scratching the surface and are in need of cleaning and resealing.

Upon lifting the door to the interior of this area the urine odor was strong enough to burn my eyes and nose.</i>
