What is the value of the check?	\$2	\$4
Can the participant “pay the difference” if the purchase price exceeds the value of the check?	Yes	Yes
Can the participant combine the check with other forms of payment (WIC VF, SNAP EBT tokens, cash)?	Yes	Yes
Can the participant receive change if the purchase price is less than the value of the check?	No	No
What is the period of time the participant can shop?	Jan 1 – Dec 31	Jun 1 – Nov 30
Is the participant’s name on the check?	No	No

What can be purchased with the check?	Any SNAP eligible food item. (e.g. fresh or frozen fruits and vegetables; meats, fish and poultry; dairy; baked goods; honey; maple syrup; food bearing seeds and plants.)	Fresh, local fruits and vegetables and culinary herbs
Does the farmer need to stamp the check with a state-issued FMNP stamp?	Yes, or initial it if the farmer does not have a state-issued FMNP stamp	Yes
Can the farmer redeem checks for cash at a KeyBank branch in New York?	No	Yes
What is the last day the farmer can redeem a check?	Jan 15 of following year	Dec 15
How does the farmer redeem the check?	By mail, address is on back of check And using the redemption form found online	At the bank, by deposit into a personal or business account at any banking institution or by cashing them at a KeyBank in New York
